Eligibility

- ▶ Program eligibility requirements are standard district-wide.
- ▶ GPA Calculations for 9th grade applicants is calculated using the average of all classes for the quarter 4 of Grade 7 and the first semester of Grade 8.
- ▶ GPA calculations for Grade 10-12 applicants will be based on the student's earned GPA at the time of eligibility determination. PBSO student's GPA will be identified from the District's Student Information System (SIS).
- ▶ Parents of students not enrolled in the SDPBC at the time of application are responsible to upload transcripts for middle school. Failure to provide official records to the high school before the application deadline WILL affect eligibility.

Marketing	GPA 2.5
HVAC-R	none
NJROTC	none

*Completion of Algebra I by Grade 8 recommended



Transportation Services

- ▶ Choice Program students may receive transportation regardless of their proximity to the Choice school.
- ▶ Parents must provide transportation to the closest bus stop in order to be eligible.
- ▶ Bus stops will only be available within the Choice Transportation Zone.
- ▶ Additional stops will not be created
- ▶ Transportation Call Center (561) 357-1110

The School District of Palm Beach County Transportation Services Department is dedicated to partnering with schools, families, and communities to provide safe and efficient transportation in support of school programs and services.

Students residing two miles or less from a school are not eligible for transportation per section 1011.68, Florida Statutes, and State Board of Education Rule 6A-3001, Basic Principles for Transportation of Students.

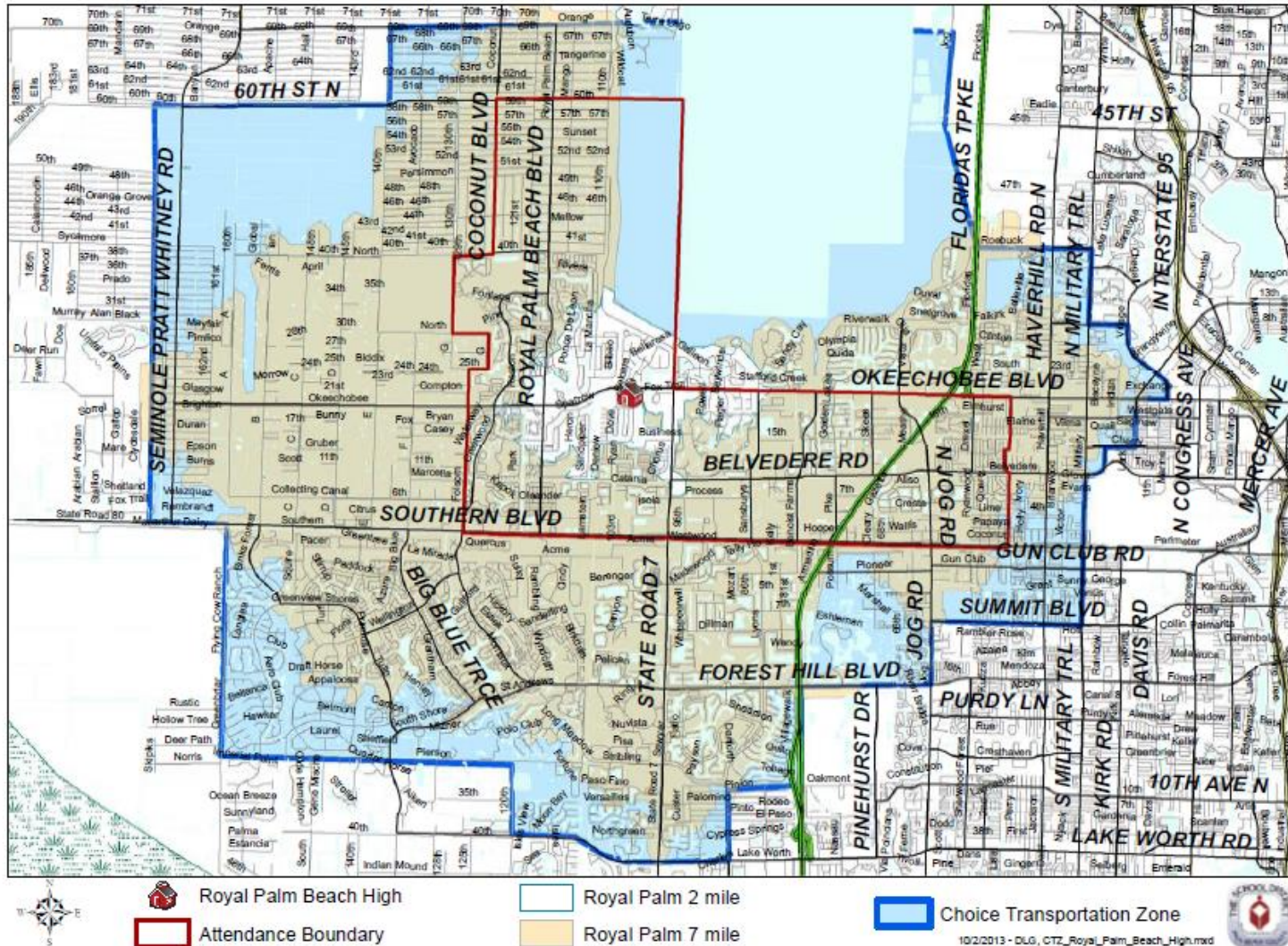

Online SDPBC CHOICE Application

- ▶ The Choice application for the 2019-2020 school year will be available **November 1, 2018**.
- ▶ Access <https://mypbchoiceapp.com/apply/index.php>.
- ▶ Only one (1) application may be submitted per student.
- ▶ Select Program Choice 1 and Program Choice 2.
- ▶ Only one (1) program selection change will be allowed prior to the application deadline once the application is submitted.



APPLY Online

- ▶ Website: <https://mypbchoiceapp.com/apply/index.php>
- ▶ Follow prompts to create application/parent dashboard.
- ▶ Ensure accuracy of information- especially e-mail address.
- ▶ Parent- not the student- submits the application.
- ▶ Parents must apply at the District for CHOICE programs even if the family lives in RPBHS's SAC zone.
- ▶ Check parent dashboard frequently for progress.



Deadlines

▶ **December 7, 2018**

(The Conservatory School @ North Palm Beach; Bak MSOA, Boynton Beach High School, and Dreyfoos School of the Arts)

▶ **January 25, 2019**

RPBHS and other schools not listed above

NOTE: Applications are not entered on a first come, first served basis. November 1 – (December 7 or) January 25 is an **open enrollment window**.



Acceptance Announcement

- ▶ Notification of acceptance from District Choice & Career options in parent dashboard first week in April 2019
- ▶ Welcome letter and documents from RPBHS via Post Office and e-mail listed in online application
- ▶ Follow accept/decline directions to reserve student's seat
